If they need to use a bathroom, use pre-agreed one (disabled at office) and then close until deep cleaned.</p> <p>If a member of staff or child wear a mask to school, they must remove and dispose of safely and wash their hands before coming into their class.</p> <p>If a child is ill with injuries, illness other than Covid-19 they can be treated as normal by staff unless the paediatric or school first aider needs to be called for an incident, as they are out of their class the first aider will then wear a mask</p> <p>Children washing hands/sanitising, on entry, before food, after sport, on exit All children have been shown how to wash hands for 20 seconds, posters in the toilets Handsoap in classrooms Sanitizer stations in classrooms Hand sanitiser available if needed.
