Dear Parent/Carers,

Welcome back for our third and final term of Year 3! I hope you all had an enjoyable Easter break and that all the children are well rested and ready for another busy term of learning.

Warmer weather:

As the weather begins to get warmer (fingers crossed) it is vital that your child has suitable protection from the sun, please ensure that your child has a sunhat that is available to wear every day for playtimes and any outside learning.

In addition, your child should have a named water bottle that remains in the classroom. Your child will be able to drink at appropriate times throughout lessons and during hot spells there will be scheduled drinks breaks.

Reading and Homework:

Homework expectations remain the same, with <u>all</u> children expected to complete 5 reads, maths homework and 300 mathletics points every week. Homework tasks are discussed in school and children should be able to complete all tasks independently although any help you offer is obviously beneficial.

PE:

PE days for the first half term will be Monday (rounders) and Tuesday (athletics). Please continue to send your child to school wearing school PE kit on these days. Your child should also wear PE kit on any days they attend sporting after school clubs.

Swimming:

After half term, William Barnes will be beginning their swimming sessions. In Year 3 our swimming sessions will be Tuesdays 1pm-2pm and Wednesday 10:45am-12pm. Please ensure your child has their swimming kit/towel and swimming hat on these days. A separate letter will be issued regarding parent volunteers and donations.
