# How Pupil Premium can help your child and the school

Every October, January and May the school has to produce a Census on the numbers of children at the school and, also in January, we report the number of children entitled to Pupil Premium. From this data the school gets £1300 per child. Please let us know if you think your child is entitled to Free School Meals (which is different to the school meals that children get in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2).

We really need to sort this by **the end of October** so please pop into the office if you think there is any likelihood of you being entitled to Free School Meals. It takes a very short time to check and is totally confidential. Thank you. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, they will also receive a free jumper in Key Stage 1 and then another in Key Stage 2. You will also be able to have financial help with residential trips in Years 4, 5 and 6.
